To Mr. John Brown, Constable of the Town of
Sudbury, in the County of Middlesex: Greeting

— You are hereby, required in the Name of the
Commonwealth of Massachusetts, to Notify and
warn, the male Inhabitants of said Town being
twenty One years of age & resident in said Town
for the space of One year next preceding having
a freehold estate within said Town of the annual
Income of three pounds, or any Estate to the Value
of sixty pounds, to assemble at the Meeting-House
in said Town, on Monday the 4th Day of Nov^r:
next at 1 o'clock in the afternoon, to give in
their votes, for a representation of the people of
said Commonwealth in the Congress of the Un-
ited States, for the Middlesex district.

— And if you are not to fail of making return of this
warrant, with your doings thereon to some one
of the Selectmen previous to the opening of said
Meeting.

Sudbury, this 21st day of October A.D. 1816.
