At a Legal Town Meeting, held in Sudbury, on Monday, the 4th Day
of November, 1816, proceeded to the business of said Day, and took up
the 1st article & made choice of William Hunt Esq^r for their Moderator,

2^d Article, the Question was put, to see if the Town, would take any
Measures, for the purpose of disposing of their Ministerial Land
in said Town, which being put to vote, it passed in the affir-
mative,

It was then voted, to appoint an agent, for the purpose of
Petitioning the Legislature of this Commonwealth for liberty to
dispose of all the Ministerial lands in said Town, and William
Hunt Esq^r was appointed, and authorized to act in behalf of
the Town, for the purpose aforesaid,

3^d Article The Town by their vote, directed their Constable, to see, that
the porch of the Meeting House, both above and below, be clear-
ed of those people who seem to be inclined, to occupy the
avenues into the meeting-house, at the commencement
of the exercise of each day of public worship — also to see
that the people, at the close of the services of each Day, pass out
in a regular manner, so that those people, who have a dispo-
sition, either, to go in or out, may not be prevented, by obsta-
cles of such a nature,

Also voted, that the Clerk of said Town, furnish an attested
copy, of the foregoing vote, to be read, by him, before the con-
gregation, on the next Sabbath, after passing said vote,

4th Article the Question, was put, to see, if the Town, would take any
Measures for disposing of the training field mentioned in
this article, & being put to vote, it passed in the affirmative

also voted, to appoint a Committee to consist of three
and the following persons were chosen, viz. Col. Rice, Capt.
Jed^d Smith, and Mr Abel Wheeler, — also directed said
Committee to proceed, & view the land and ascertain as near
as may be, what they can have for it, Provided, the Town shall
see fit to dispose of said land, & to report to the Town,
