

January Anno Domini 1817

Addresd to Mr. John Brown, Constable of the Town
of Sudbury in Said County, — Greeting —

You are hereby required, in the Name of the
Commonwealth of Massachusetts, to Notify and
Warn, the Freeholders, and other Inhabitants of the
Town of Sudbury, Qualificd, as the Law directs, to
Vote, in Town affairs, to assemble at the Meet-
ing-House in Said Town, on Monday the 20th
Day of January Instant at 1 o'clock in the Af-
ternoon, on Said Day, then & there, to act on the
following Articles, Viz, —

1st To Choose a Moderator, —

2^d To see, if the Town, will take any Measures for the
purpose of taking into their consideration, the alter-
ing the Mode, & fixing upon a suitable Sum,
as a Salary to be offered to Mr. Rufus Hurlbut,
(Different from that which their Committee reported
& the Town accepted, on the 30th Decr. last,) it being
by the request of a Number of the Inhabitants of
Said Town, — to do or act ~~any way~~ as it
respects, the carrying into effect, what is mentioned
in this article, as the Town, shall think best when
Met, —

3^d To see, if the Town will give their Committee
which were appointed for the purpose of Viewing
the land called the Old training field Near Jona-
than Clarke, any Directions respecting their dis-
posing of Said land, either at Public Vendue, or any
Other way, they shall think best, to do or act, &c.

4th To Attend, to any, or all reports, to be made by Com-
mittees, should any reports be offered, to do, or, act,

— Hereof you are not to fail of making re-
turn, of this warrant, with your doings
