Sudbury January 20th 1817

In Obedience to the within warrant I have notified, and
warned the Freeholders, & other Inhabitants, of the Town of
Sudbury by posting a ^{true} Copy of the Original, at the Meeting
House, agreeable to the Vote of the Town, John Brown, Comptroller
of Sudbury.

At a Town Meeting, legally held in Sudbury on Monday the 20th
Day of January, 1817, provided to the business of said day & took up the
1st article and made choice of M^r. Abel Wheeler, for their Moderator, —
2^d article, the Question was put, to see, if the Town, would take up
this article to act upon and it passed in the affirmative, —
It was then voted, that M^r. Hurlbut should be requested, to tarry
at his boarding place this afternoon in order, that he might
receive communications, from the Town, should they desire to
make them, — and M^r. Josiah Goodnow, was appointed for
that purpose, — the Question was then put, (after their
had been a considerable discussion upon the subject matter
of this article) to see if the Town would take any measures
for altering the Mode, & fixing upon a suitable Sum, as
a Salary to be offered to M^r. Hurlbut, as mentioned in
this article, and being put to vote, it passed in the affirma-
tive, by 67 for & 46 against it, —
It was then voted, that the Committee, which waited
on M^r. Hurlbut, at the last Meeting, and made their
report,
