Middlesex, ss, To Mr. John Brown, Constable of
the Town of Sudbury in said County. Greeting
you are hereby required in name of the Com-
monwealth of Massachusetts to notify & warn the
Freeholders, and other Inhabitants, of the Town
of Sudbury qualified by law, to vote, in Town affairs
to assemble at the Meeting House in said Town on
Monday the 3^d Day of March next at 10 o'clock in
the forenoon on said Day, then & there to act on
the following articles viz -

- 1st To choose a Moderator, Town Clerk, Selectmen,
Town Treas^r Officers, Constable, and all other
Town officers, required by Law to be annually
chosen in the Month of March or April
- 2^d To see if the Town, will repair their Highways by
a rate the present year, and grant a suitable
sum of Money for repairing the same -
- 3^d To see if the Town will give liberty for swine
to go at large the present year
- 4th To see if the Town will give liberty for Horses
Mules, & Neat Cattle, to go at large the present year
- 5th To see if the Town will give liberty for sheep
to go at large without being under the care
of a shepherd the present year -
- 6th To see if the Town will accept the settlement
of the Selectmen with the Town Treas^r & order
the same to be recorded -
- 7th To see if the Town will take Measures for the
purpose of agreeing with some suitable person
or persons to collect the Taxes that may be
assessed upon the Inhabitants of said Town 46.1
for the year ensuing to do or act as the
Town shall think proper when met
