To Mr. John Brown Constable of the Town of Sud-
bury in the County of Middlesex. — Greeting

So, you are hereby required in the name of the Common-
wealth of Massachusetts. To notify and warn all
the Inhabitants of said Town & qualified by law as
is provided in the Constitution of this Commonwealth
to vote in the choice of Gov^r. Lient. Gov^r. & Senators
for the year ensuing, to assemble at the Meeting
House in said Town on Monday the 7th day of
April next at 1 o'clock in the afternoon on
said day to give in their votes for Gov^r. Lient.
Gov^r. of said Commonwealth & Senators for Mid-
dlessex district for the year in coming —
— Hereof you are not to fail of making return
of this warrant, with your doing thereon to
some one of the selectmen, previous to the
opening said Meeting —

said this 24 Day of March A.D. 1817.
