ium aforesaid or any part thereof, except when
any person, may be illegally assessed, or by
means of extreme poverty, or other unforeseen
casualties, shall put it out of the power of the
Collector to collect of such particular person.
his delinquency, so far only as it may apply
to such particular cases, shall not vitiate his
claim for premium on such sums as he shall actually
pay in as aforesaid.
