5th article the Town voted to have the Ordination sermon printed at the expence of said Town, then voted to appoint a committee and the following Gentlemen were appointed viz - William Hunt Esq. Dea. Samuel Puffer & Mr Daniel Osborn to care it in to affect

6th article referred to May Meeting for further consideration

7th article the Town voted to authorize their old committee to give a deed & take security running to the Town Treas^r for the old training field. then the Town reconsidered the above vote, and ^{the Town} voted to appoint Cole Jones Rice & authorize him to give a deed & take security running to the Town Treas^r for the old training field so called near John Clarks

8th article put over without action on

9th article referred to May Meeting for further consideration

10th article the Town voted to appoint a committee to sell a piece of wood land near Mr Gleason at public vendue and authorize them to give a deed & take security & the following Gentlemen were appointed viz Cole Jones Rice Capt Wm Brigham & Mr Paul Walker

11th article put over to May Meeting

12th article the Town voted to appropriate the Remainder of the three hundred dollars granted in 1816 for preaching -ing, to the Revd Rufus Herlbut toward his salary the year ensuing, also to appropriate the Remainder of the money in the committee hands from the sale of wood & not otherway appropriated to the Revd Rufus Herlbut toward his salary the year ensuing -

then the Town by their vote dissolved this Meeting
