

May Anno Domini, 1817

- 7th To see if the Town will grant Money for to pay their Treas^r and Assessors for the present year to do or Act &c
- 8th To see if the Town will grant to Mr. Kneben Maynard the sum of ~~the~~ ^{one} dollars if being in full for his entertaining the Council according to agreement with the Committee to do or Act &c
- Also to see if the Town will grant to Mr. Kneben Maynard a sum of Money sufficient to pay for a cask of Powder bot off Cole Boat it being for the Town stock to do or Act &c
- 9th To see if the Town will appropriate to Mr. Benj^r Dudley a sum sufficient to pay him for his outst standing orders, out of Money unappropriated if any there be, Also to appropriate or grant a sum of Money sufficient to pay Mr. Timothy Biglow his Account to do or Act &c
- 10th To see if the Town will appoint some suitable persons to take care & sweep the Meeting House King the Hall and dig graves as occasions may require, to do, or, Act &c
- 11th To see if the Town will act on the 12th article in the morning of March Meeting & refer to April & so on to May, Also the 6th 9th & 11th Articles in the morning of April Meeting and refer to May for further consideration
- 12th To see if the Town will agree to do to the Ordination sermon the Charge & right hand fellowship and order their Committee to have it printed at the expense of the Town
- 13th To see if the Town will look up the bounds of their Highway and appoint a Committee for that purpose to do, or Act &c it being agreeable to the request of Mr. Eben^r Permenter and others
- 14th To see if the Town will purchase the land & Building thereon formerly belonging to John Green, and set off to Mr. Kneben Maynard by execution it being at the request of Mr. Maynard to do or Act &c
- 15th To see if the Town will give any encouragement to such persons as shall use the means of destroying graves within the limits of said Town it being agreeable to the request of Mr. Elisha Hunt to do or Act &c
