By Order of the Town of Sudbury, To Mr. Walter Hayes, Constable of the

you are hereby required, in the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, to Notify the Inhabitants of said Town, duly qualified by Law, for the respective purposes of voting in the choice of Town officers and other Town matters, to meet at the meeting-house in said Town, on Monday the 2^d day of March Next at 10 o'clock in the forenoon, on said Day then & there to act on the following articles VIZT. —

1st To choose a Moderator, Town Clerk, Selectmen, Town Treasurer, Assessors, constables, and all other Town Officers, required by Law, to be annually chosen in the Months of March, or April.

2^d To see, if the Town, will repair their Highways by a rate the present year, and grant a suitable sum of money, for repairing the same.

3^d To see, if the Town will give liberty for Swine to go at large the present year.

4th To see if the Town, will give liberty for Horses, Mules, and Neat cattle, to go, at large, the present year.

5th To see, if the Town, will give liberty for sheep to go at large, without being under the care of a Shepherd, the present year.

6th To see if the Town, will accept the settlement of the Selectmen, with the Town Treas^r, and order the same to be recorded.

7th To see, if the Town, will take measures for the purpose of agreeing with some suitable,
