Suitable person, or persons, to collect the taxes that may be assessed upon the Inhabitants of said Town, for the year ensuing, to do or act as the Town shall think proper when met, &c.

8th To see, if the Town, will appoint some Suitable persons for a school committee, and authorize them to agree with and hire school Instructors, & Instruct all the public schools in said Town, for the year ensuing, to do or act, &c.

9th To see, if the Town will adopt the same measures the present year, respecting collecting their taxes that was the year past, or any other measures the Town shall think best when met, &c.

10th To see, if the Town will take any measures to relieve the poor, by expensive, either by providing a workhouse, or any other way, the Town shall think best when met, to do or act &c.

11th To see, if the Town will attend to the reports, of the trustees of the ministerial fund, corporation of their doings respecting the sale of the ministerial lands in said Town, and the state of the fund, agreeable to the act of Incorporation, and also all other reports that may be made by committees, if any there should be made, &c.

12th To see, if the Town, will direct their committee appointed to sell the land near M^r. Gleason, to sell it under the present Incumbrances, it being agreeable to the request of said committee, &c.
