Mr. Willis, Mr. Elisha Hunt, and Mr. Jona Fairbanks,
— also Invested said Committee with the same powers
and authority, the School committee were invested with the
year past, — also established the same rules, orders
and discipline, that were to be observed in each par-
ticular School, the last year, —

9th Article referred to April meeting for further consideration

11th attended to the report of the trustees of the Ministerial
fund corporation, which report, (is as it stands here-
— after recorded,) it being accepted by vote, & ordered to
be recorded, —

12th attended to the report of the committee appointed
to see the Land near Mr. Sam^l Gleasons, who report-
— ed, they had been on and examined the land, and
had by the best enquiry they could make, been un-
— able to find out the certainty of a way to said land
excepting upon sufferance, therefore they had not as
yet disposed of it, and wished for some directions re-
— specting said business, — the Question was then
put, to see, if the Town would direct their committee
to sell said land at Vendue, to the highest bidder, &
to warrant the purchaser, a road to said land, which
being put to vote, passed in the Negative —

— It was then moved by Mr. Asa Willis, to see if the
Town would choose two men, not belonging to Town &
he to choose one, to appraise said land, & being put
to vote, passed in the Negative —

— the Question was then put to see if the Town wo-
— uld direct their committee to sell said land, without
warranting or giving any encouragement respect-
— ing a road to said land and being put to vote,
it passed in the Affirmative —
the trustees. —
