

March Anno Domini 1818, -----

The trustees of the Sudbury Ministerial fund corporation, by an act of the legislature of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, passed June 14th of A.D. 1817, authorising the said trustees to make sale of all the ministerial lands in the said Town of Sudbury, and also to report to the Town, the State of the funds, arising from the sale of said lands, and their doings thereon, at the annual meeting in March, or April, Agreeable to said act, ask leave to report, as follows, Viz^t -----
