At a Legal Town Meeting held in Sudbury

on Monday the fourth Day of May 1818

Proceeded to the business of said Day —

It was Mov^d to see if the Town would send a
Representative the present year and it pass^d
in the affirmative.

Then the Town proceeded to bring in their votes
for the choice of a Representative and Capt^l
Isaac Gibbs being a freeholder & resident in
said Town was made choice of to serve and
represent said Town in General Court for
the year ensuing having the number of
thirty eight votes ~~off~~ ^{Mr} Abel Wheeler thirty
five votes

Then the Town by their vote dissolved this
Meeting

Middlesex Co. May 4th 1818 —

Then personally appeared Asher Goodnow
and made Oath, that in the office of Town
Clerk Pro, Tempore within the Town of Sudbury
where to he is chosen he would diligently and faith-
fully attend and discharge the duty of his place
and duly observe the directions of the Law in all
things where to his Office his relations and thereby
committed to his care and trust.
