of a Grammar school for the year ensuing and
order where the same shall be kept to do or act &c

5th To see if the Town will Grant Money for the support
of a Reading & writing School for the year ensuing
and order where the same shall be kept to do or act &c

6th To see if the Town will Grant Money for the
relief of the Poor belonging to said Town for the
year ensuing —

7th To see if the Town will Grant Money to pay
their Treasure and Assessors for the present
year to do or act &c

8th To see if the Town will appoint some suitable 66.1
person to take care of sweep the Meeting house
ring the Bell and dig graves on occasions may
require for the year ensuing to do or act &c
