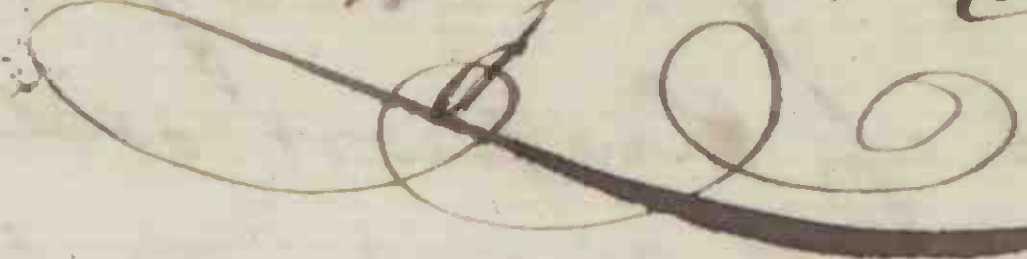


May Anno Domini, 1818

At a Town Meeting Legally held in Sudbury
on Monday the 4th Day of May 1818 proceeded

3^d Article Grant^d to the Rev^d Rufus Hurlbut
\$449.39 with the Interest on the Ministerial
funds for his salary the year ensuing
amounting in the whole to the sum of = \$650.00

4 th Grant ^d for the support of a grammar school School the year ensuing \$375.00 to be equally divided between the five school	375 00
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5 th ^{Districts} Grant ^d for the support of a reading and wrighting school the year ensuing the sum of \$125.00 to be equally divided between the five school Districts —	125 00
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Also Grant ^d for Wood \$25.00 to be equally divided between the five school Districts —	25 00
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6 th Grant ^d for the support of the poor belong- ing to said Town for the year ensuing	1000 00
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7 th Grant ^d to pay their Treasurers the present year the sum of —	7 00
To pay their Assessors the sum of —	20 00
