10th Granted for the support of a singing school the sum of \$40.00 - then it was moved & voted to appoint a committee to superintend the laying out of \$40.00 said grant & the following gentlemen were appointed
Capt Isaac Gibbs Dea Samuel Puffer & Capt Israel Haynes

11th Article past over not to be acted on

12th it was moved & voted to see if the Town would open the road as is expressed in this 12 Article and it passed in the negative
