=ance, and the laying out a road petitioned for by S<sup>r</sup>. Asa  
Smith of Stow, so far across the Elizabeth river untill  
it comes to Stow line, from the termination of a Highway  
lately laid out and established by the town of Sudbury  
to do or Act as the town shall think best when met.

3<sup>d</sup> To see if the town will grant a suitable sume of money to  
repair the Highways in said town to do, or Act be

4<sup>th</sup> To see if the town will grant a sufficient sume of money  
to pay Col. Frost for two Casks Powder to furnish the  
town with a sufficient stock of Ammunition to <sup>be</sup> used

5<sup>th</sup> To see if the town will Establish a road where it is  
now traveled across Mr. Phineas Russers land to  
~~that road~~ that leads to May and Co. Millers in said town  
it being agreeable to the request of Mr. May to do or Act be
