- At a Town Meeting legally held in Sudbury on Thurs-
day the 10th day of Sept^r 1818. proceeded upon business
of said day, taking up the ---
1st Article and chose William Hunt for their Moderator
2^d Article it was moved and led to ~~decide~~ if the town would
chose a Committee to appose a road ~~as expressed~~ in this
article and passed in the affirmative, then the town voted ~~that~~
that Committee should consist of three and the following
persons were chosen (viz) William Hunt Esq. Micah
Balcom and Col. Jon^a Rice, then Col. Rice asked to be
excused from serving on the the Committee, and was
excused, and Abel Wheeler was appointed in his stead
3^d Article passed over not acted upon ---
4th Article voted to grant the sum of \$ 16.00 Dollars for
the purpose of paying Col. Hunt for two casks of Powder
5th Article passed over not acted upon ---

Then the town voted to dissolve this Meeting
