At a legal Meeting of the Inhabitants of the
town of Sudbury in the County of Middlesex
and Commonwealth of Massachusetts qualified by
the Constitution to vote for Representatives in the
General Court held on the second day of
November (being the first Monday of said Month)
in the year of our Lord one thousand eight
hundred and eighteen for the purpose giving in
their votes for a Representative of said Com=
monwealth in Congress of the United States for
the Middlesex District. The whole number of
votes given in were sorted and counted and
recorded and Declaration thereof made as by
law is directed and were for the following persons

For Hon. Timothy Fuller fifty votes

For Hon. Samuel R. P. Gay one vote

Then the town by their vote

disolved this Meeting
