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You are hereby required in the name of the Commonwealth of
Massachusetts to notify and warn all the freeholders and other
other inhabitants of the town of Sudbury qualified by law
to vote in town affairs to meet at the Meeting House in
said town on Monday the 2^d day of November next at
3 O'clock in the afternoon to act on the following Articles

1st To chuse a Moderator

2^d To see if the town will except of a road as laid out by the
Selectmen through the land of Mr. Phemias Ruffer to meet
the road lately laid out to Mr. May & Co. Mills it being a
grueable to a Petition of Mr. May & Co. ~~in reference to being~~
~~had in a way~~

3^d To see if the town will except of the reports of Committee if
any there should be made

4th To see if the town will build whirs to convey the dirt to their
graves in said town to do or act as the the town shall think
best when meet

5th To see if the town will hear the Selectmen statement respec-
-ting Catharine and Paul Robinson and family and to chuse
and adjoint or adjoints to Prosecute the town of Stow if they
should refuse to take them or to do or act as the town shall
think best when meet

Here of you are not to fail of making a return of this war-
-rant with your doings there on to some one of the selectmen
previous to the spring said meeting
