Meddesee fs. Sudbury October 2^d 1818~

Pursuant to the within Warrant I have Notified
and warned all the freeholders and other Inhabitants
to Meet at the time and Place and for the purposes
within mentioned according to Law~

At a legal Town meeting held in Sudbury on the 2^d
day of November 1818. proceeded upon business of said
day by taking the 1st Article and made choice of
William Hurst Esq. Moderator

2^d Article then the town excepted the road as laid out
by the selectmen through the land of Mr. Thomas
Puffer as expressed in this Article, also voted the
sum of \$ 8. Dollars for to compensate Mr. Thomas
Puffer for his land where said road is laid out~

3^d Article, attended to the report of the committee appointed
to appose a road petitioned for by Asa Smith from
his saw Mill to his grist Mill the said report was made
in writing as follows, viz. The committee appointed
to appose a road petitioned for by Asa Smith from his
saw Mill have attended that survey and employed an
attorney to make the defence against the exception
of said road and after the ^{report} being heard the court rejected
the Report of their committee. William Hurst

4th article the town voted to build a horse, and appointed
the selectmen a committee to build said horse, and to
procure a harness for the same.

5th article after the selectmen had read their statement as
expressed in this article, it was moved and sec. to see
if the town would chuse adjoints to prosecute the Town
of Stow, if they should refuse to take, Catherine and Paul
Robinson and family and passed in the affirmative
and the selectmen were chosen for that purpose
where the town by their vote dissolved this Meeting.
