

March Anno Domini 1819

To Mr^r Waller Haymer Constable of the Town of Sudbury in
the County of Middlesex Greeting

As You are hereby required in the name of the Common-
wealth of Massachusetts, to notify and warn, the Freeholders
and other Inhabitants of the Town of Sudbury Qualified
by Law, to vote in Town Meetings, to Assemble at the
Meeting House in said Town on Monday the 1st day of
March next at 10, O'clock in the forenoon, on said day
then and there to act on the following articles, viz-

1st To choose a Moderator, Town Clerk, Selectmen, Town
Treasr^r & Assessors Constable and all other Town officers
required by law to be annually chosen in the Month
of March or April

2^d To see if the Town will Repair their Highway by a
rate the present year and Grant a suitable sum
of Money for repairing the same

3^d To see if the Town will give liberty for swine to go
at large the present year

4th To see if the Town will give liberty for Horses, Mules &
Beast Cattle to go at large the present year

5th To see if the Town will give liberty for sheep to go at
large without a shepherd the present year

6th To see if the Town will except the settlement
of the Selectmen with the Town Treasr^r and order
the same to be recorded

7th To see if the Town will take the same Measures
for the purpose of collecting the Taxes that may
be assessed, upon the Inhabitants of said Town as was
adopted the last year, And to agree with some suitable
person or persons to collect the same for the year
ensuing to do and act, as the Town shall think best
where met.
