- 8th To see if the Town will appoint some suitable persons for a School Committee and authorize them to agree with & hire school Instructors and Instructors to instruct all the Public schools in said Town for the year ensuing to do or Act &c
- 9th To see if the Town will ~~except~~ attend to the report of the Trustees of the Sudbury Ministerial fund Corporation the state of the funds and the Interest arising there on - -
- 10th To see if the Town will Instruct their Overseers of the Poor, to let out the Poor of said Town no longer than the fifteenth day of March next ensuing said letting out of the same - -
- 11th To see if the Town will Discount or allow to Constitute Walter Haynes such Taxes as he hold, against the Inhabitants of said Town as may appear necessary to be Discounted to do or Act &c
- 12th To see ^{whether} if the Town will take any measures to request the Rev. Mr. ~~Walter~~ Wright to exchange with the Rev. Mr. Hurlburt it being agreeable to the request of the Rev. Mr. Hurlburt - -
- 13th To see if the Town will charge a Committee and otherwise them with full power and authority to settle a dispute between Mr. Ruben Maynard and Constable Walter Haynes, respecting the fifty dollars that is on the Credit bill through a mistake which Constable Haynes says he has paid and Mr. Maynard says he has not rec'd to do or Act any other way on this Article as the Town shall think best when met. - -
- 14th To see if the Town will or otherwise the selectmen to nominate the Highway Surveyors the present year and pay them a reasonable sum for their services it being agreeable to the request of ^{Mr.} Luther Goodnow - -
- 15th To see if the Town will give liberty for Messrs Loring Wheeler James Quin and Messrs John Hayward to draw their proportionate part of their school Money to be granted the ~~present~~ year ~~it being~~ it being agreeable to the request of Mr. Loring Wheeler

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
