Donation fund as follows -

By an act of the Legislature of the Commonwealth of
Massachusetts passed June the 14th 1817 establishing a Min-
isterial Fund in the town of Sudbury. Making it a duty of
the trustees thereof to make a report to the Town the state of
the fund, and then doing thereon at the annual Meeting
in the Month of March or April agreeable to said, Act &c
leave to report, as follows (viz) That the funded sum
consist of the following votes of hand bearing Date August
the 30th 1817 (viz)
