ensuing to assemble at the Meeting House in said
Town on Monday the 5th Day of April next at 1 o'clock
in the afternoon, on said day there & there to give
in their votes for the choice of Gov^t & Lemt Gov^t
of said Commonwealth & senators for Middlesex dis-
-trict for the year ensuing

Hereof you are not to fail of making returns of
this warrant with your doing thereon to some
one of the selectmen, previous to the opening
said Meeting
