Ls. you are hereby required in the name of the Commonwealth  
Ls. of Massachusetts, to notify & warn all the Inhabitants of said  
Ls. Town, Inhabited by the Constitution of this Commonwealth, to  
Ls. vote in the choice of Representative and all others Inhabited  
Ls. as the Law directs to vote in Town affairs to Assemble at  
the Meeting House in said Town on Monday the 6th day of  
April next, at three o'clock in the afternoon on said day  
to act on the following Articles, viz:-----

1<sup>st</sup> To choose a Moderator -----

2<sup>d</sup> To bring in their votes for some suitable person for a County  
Treasurer for the year ensuing -----

3<sup>d</sup> To fill vacancies in <sup>these</sup> Town officers, which the Law requires should  
any officer appear to be vacant -----

4<sup>th</sup> To see if the Town will act upon the 6<sup>th</sup> & 11<sup>th</sup> articles in the  
warning of March Meeting & refer to April <sup>meeting</sup> for further consi-  
deration to do or act as the Town shall think best when met

5<sup>th</sup> To attend to any or all reports to be made by Committees should  
any reports be offered to be made -----

6<sup>th</sup> To see if the Town would grant a suitable sum of Money to  
make the new road near Mr. May agreeable to the request  
of said May to do or act as the Town shall think best when  
met -----
