the Meeting House in said Town on Monday the
3^d Day of May next, at one o'clock in the afternoon
for the purpose of choosing a Representative to
represent them in the General Court appointed
to be convened and held at Boston on the last
Wednesday of May next —

Warrant with your doing thereon to some of the
Selectmen previous to the opening said meeting
Given under our hand & seal at Sudbury this 19th
Day of April, A.D. 1819
