of the poor belonging to said Town for the year en-
suing ———
7th To see if the Town will Grant Money to pay their
Treas^r & Assessors for the present year to do or act &c
8th To see if the Town will appoint some suitable person to
take care of sweep the Meeting House ring the Bell and
dig graves on occasions may require for the year ensuing
to do or act &c ———
9th To see if the Town will act upon the 3rd & 6th Articles
in the warning of April Meeting & refer to May Meeting
