- 10th To see if the Town will appoint an agent to approve the Partition of Ebenezer Eaton & others for a road in the south part of Sudbury agreeable to the request of Mr John Brown to do or act as the Town shall think best when met
 - 11th To see if the Town will appoint an agent with full power & authority to settle or defend a suit if brought by Boston against Sudbury on account of William Miller & family to do or act &c
 - 12th To see if the Town will take any Measures for repairing the New House to do or act &c
 - 13th To attend to any or all reports if any reports be offered to be made
 - 14th To see if the Town will except of a list of grievances as presented by the selectmen to do or act &c
- Here of you are not to fail of Making returns of this Warrant with your doing thereon to the selectmen previous to the opening said Meeting
