At a Town Meeting legally held in Sudbury on Monday the 23^d day of August, A.D. 1819 — Proceeded to the business of said day, and took up the 1st article and made choice of William Hunt Esq. for their Moderator —

1st after a short conference on this article the Town voted to have the Highway Surveyors go by themselves and report to the ~~Said~~ Town what sum would be sufficient to repair their Highways for the present

2^d Then the Town took up the third article and granted the sum of Ten Dollars for the purpose expressed in said article

Then the Town attended to the report of their Highway Surveyors as follows, that in their opinion it was necessary to grant the sum of five hundred Dollars then it was ~~Mov^d~~ & second to grant the above sum and it passed in the affirmative, then the Town voted to have the aforesaid Make it into a tax and deliver it to the several Surveyors of Highway in said Town and for them to work it out under the same directions they did the other Highway tax, then the Town voted to dissolve this Meeting
