To the Town of Sudbury in said County - - - greeting
You are hereby required in the name of the
Commonwealth of Massachusetts, to Notify and warn
all the Freeholders & other Inhabitants of the Town of
Sudbury qualified by law to vote in Town affairs
to Assemble at the Meeting House in said Town on
Monday the 6th day of March next at 10 o'clock in
the forenoon on said day then and there to act
on the following Articles viz -
1st To Choose a Moderator, Town Clerk, Selectmen Town
Treasr. Assessors, Constable and all other Town officers
required by Law, to be Annually chosen in the Month
of March or April -
2^d To see if the Town will repair their Highway by a
rate, the present year, and grant a suitable sum
of Money for repairing the same -
3^d To see if the Town will give liberty for swine to go
at large the present year -
4th To see if the Town will give liberty for Horses Mules
and Cattle to go at large the present year -
5th To see if the Town will give liberty for sheep to
go at large without a Shepherd the present year -
6th To see if the Town will except of the settlement of the
Selectmen with the Town Treasr. and order the
same to be recorded -
7th To see if the Town will take the same Measures
for the purpose of collecting the taxes that may
be assessed upon the Inhabitants of said Town, as was
Adopted the last year, and to agree with some
suitable person or persons, to Collect the same for
the year ensuing to do or act as the Town shall
think best when Met -
8th To see if the Town will appoint some suitable persons
for a School Committee & authorize them to agree
with & hire school Instructors & Instructresses to
Instruct all the Public schools in said Town
for the year ensuing to do or act as

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
