9th the Town voted to except of the report of the trustees of the Ministerial fund corporation and ordered to be recorded as follows

by an act of the Legislature of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts passed June 14th 1817 - Establishing a Ministerial Fund in the Town of Andover making it a duty of the trustees thereof to make a report to the Town the state of the funds and their doing thereon at the annual Meeting in the month of March or April agreeable to said act ask leave to report as follows (viz) That the funded sum consists of the following votes of hand having date August 30th 1818 (viz)
