expressed to meet at the time and place and for the
purpose therein mentioned

At a Town Meeting legally held in Sudbury on

Monday the 3^d day of April, A.D. 1820

Proceeded to the business of said day & took up
1st the first article & made choice of Mr. Abel Wheeler
for their Moderator

2^d brought in their rates for County Treas^r as
follows

for } John Meyer Esq. Eighty six Rates

3^d To fill up Vacancies of Town Officers

Mr. Gillay Haynes was chosen for the 5th Selectman

Mr. Samuel Knight was chosen Constable for the
year ensuing and was sworn in the same district

then Mr. Paul Walker came forward & excused himself
from serving as school committee man in the south
west district then they chose Capt. Fairbanks & he

excused himself & chose Mr. Adams Howe in his
room, then Mr. Obadiah Osborn excused himself

from serving in said corner for the center district
and Capt. Jediah Smith was chosen and he excused

himself and Mr. Walter Haynes was chosen in
his room

4th Containing the 6th article in the warning of March
Meeting & referred to April Meeting for further
consideration the Town voted to except of
the settlements of the Selectmen with the
Town Treas^r & ordered it to be recorded
