the warning of March Meeting & referred to April

The Town voted to pass over the 10th & 11th Articles ~~not to~~
to be acted on

5th After a long debate it was Mov^d & second to see if the Town
will act upon the 5th Article & if passed in the affirmative
then the Town voted to put it over to May Meeting
for further consideration

6th The Town voted to grant fifty cents a piece to ~~all the~~
Militia soldiers ~~in the Town of Sudbury~~ to furnish
them with Powder & a Dinner when ^{ever} they are
obliged to ~~be in~~ ^{muster} Regiment and do actually appear
in the field and not otherwise

then the Town took up the third Article again
and incurred Mr John Stone from serving as
one of the Highway surveyors for the present
year & chose Mr William Stone in his Room
and he was sworn as the Law directs

Then the Town voted to dissolve this Meeting
