Monday the 1st day of May, A.D. 1820 proceeded to the
business of said day by bringing in their votes for
the choice of a Representative and Capt Isaac Gibbs
being a freeholder & resident in said Town was made
choice of to serve and Represent said Town in General
Court for the year ensuing having the Number
of sixty six votes and At. Abel Wheeler having
the Number of eight votes
then the Town by their vote Dissolved this Meeting
