4th To see if the Town will Grant Money for the support
of a Grammar school for the year ensuing and order
where the same shall be kept to do or act &c —

5th To see if the Town will Grant Money for the support
of a Reading & writing school for the year ensuing
and order Where the same shall be kept to do or act &c —

6th To see if the Town will Grant Money for the relief of the
Poor belonging to said Town for the year ensuing

7th To see if the Town will Grant Money to pay their
Treas^r & assessors for the present year to do or act

8th To see if the Town will appoint some suitable persons to
take care of & sweep the Meeting House ring the
Bell and dig graves on occasion May require for
the year ensuing to do or act &c —

9th To see if the Town will act on the 3th Articles in the
warning of April Meeting & refer^d to May for
further Consideration —
