- 11th To see if the Town will appoint an agent or agents to commence a suit against the Inhabitants of the Town of Harvard for the support of the Widow Elizabeth Willard, also to see if the Town will appoint an agent or agents to commence a suit against the Inhabitants of the Town of Petersham or East Sudbury for the support of the support of Ashbel Stone & family to do or act &c
- 12th To see if the Town will except of a Road if laid out by the Selectmen from Mr. Obediah Perry, toward Mr. Jonathan Fairbanks to do or act &c
- 13th To see if the Town will take any Measures for the purpose of repairing the School House in the northeast district to do or act &c
