 Monday the 1st day of May, A.D. 1820 - proceeded
 to the business of said day and took up the 1st Article
 1st and made choice of Capt Isaac Gibbs for their Moderator
 2^d Article put over for the present
 3^d Granted to the Rev^d Rufus Burdett for his salary
 the year ensuing, ~~with the~~ 457.95 with
 the interest on the donation fund of 192.05 650 00
 4th Granted for the support of a Grammar School
 for the year ensuing \$875 00 to be equally
 divided between the five school districts 375 00
 5th Granted for the support of a Reading & writing
 school for the year ensuing \$150 to be
 equally divided between the five school districts 150 00
 Also granted for wood \$25.00 to be equally divided
 between the five school districts 25 00
 6th Granted for the support of the poor belonging
 to said Town for the year ensuing 900 00
 7th Granted to pay their Treas^r the present year 10 00
 Also to pay their Assessors for the present year 20 00
 8th The Town by their vote directed the selectmen
 to agree with some suitable person to take care of
 and sweep the Meeting house ring the Bell and
 dig graves as occasions may require
 9th Containing the 5th Article in the warning of April
 Meeting and referred to May for further consideration
 passed over not to be acted on
 10th The Town voted to direct their present Treas^r
 to collect the old Grants as was expressed in the
 10th Article in the corps of the present year
 Also their small notes in the Treasury or the
 interest as was expressed in said article, in
 corps of the present year
 11th passed over not to be acted on
 12th - passed over
