To Middleser, ss. To Mr. Samuel Knight Constable of the
Town of Sudbury in said County

Greeting

You are hereby required in the Name of the Common
wealth of Massachusetts to Notify & warn all the Free-
holders and other Inhabitants of said Town Quali-
fied as the Law directs to vote in Town affairs to
assemble at the Meeting House in said Town on
Monday the 6 day of June next at 4 O'clock in the
afternoon to act on the following articles viz -

1st To choose a Moderator

2^d To see if the Town will Indemnify Mr. Martin
Brown from all cost that he arises or
may arise in defending a suit brought against
him by Mr. Isaac Puffer for his Plough on
the Highway to do or act, as the Town shall
think best when met

3^d To see if the Town will direct their Highway
surveyors to allow for all Ploughs used on the
Highway out of the Highway taxes to do or act

Hereof you are not to fail of Making return
of this Warrant with your doing thereon to
some one of the selectmen previous to the
Opening said Meeting
