of the Town of Sudbury in said County - Greeting
You are hereby required in the Name of the
Commonwealth of Massachusetts to Notify and
Warn all the Freeholders and Other Inhabitants
of said Town qualified to vote for Senators or
Representative in the General Court to assemble
at the Meeting House in said Town on
Monday the twenty first instant at one
O'clock in the afternoon to give in their
votes by ballot on this question is it expedient
that Delegates should be chosen to
meet in convention for the purpose
of revising or altering the Constitution
of Government of this Commonwealth
Hereof said and make return of this
Warrant with your doing thereon to some
one of the Selectmen previous to opening
said Meeting -
