Twenty first day of August A.D. 1820 Proceeded to the
business of said day by bringing in their votes by ballot
is it expedient that Delegates should be chosen to meet
in convention for the purpose of revising or alter-
ing the constitution of Government of this Commonwealth

For said Measures there were Four votes - -

Against said Measures there were Forty two votes - -

Thus the Town by their Vote Disposed this Meeting

Middlesex Co. Attest Samuel Knight Constable of the
Town of Sudbury in said County - - Greeting

Ye are hereby required in the name of the Commonwealth
of Massachusetts to Notify and warn all the Freeholders and other
Inhabitants of said Town Qualified to Vote for Representatives
in the general Court, to Assemble at the Meeting House in
said Town on Monday the sixteenth Instant at one O'clock
in the afternoon to Elect one Delegate to meet Delegates from
other Towns in convention at the State House in Boston, on
the third Wednesday of next month to take into consideration
the propriety and expediency of Making any (and if any what)
Alterations or amendment in the present Constitution of
Government of the Commonwealth and then and there to
divide and do all such Matters and things, as in & by said act
relating to the calling of a convention for the purpose
of revising or altering the Constitution are required or
authorised to be done - -

Hereof you are not to fail of making return of this
Warrant with your doing thereon to some one of the
selectmen previous to opening said Meeting
Given under our hand & seals at Sudbury aforesaid
this 2^d day of Oct^r A.D. 1820 - -
