Pursuant to a Law of this Commonwealth, the Inhabitants of the Town of Sudbury in the County of Middlesex qualified according to the Constitution, to vote for Representatives in the general court, having been duly convened in Town Meeting, on the sixteenth day of Oct^r, being the third Monday of said Month, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty, to elect one Delegate to meet Delegates from other Towns in convention, at Boston on the third Wednesday of Nov^r next, for the purpose of revising the Constitution of Government of this Commonwealth, did then and there elect William Hunt Esq^r to be their Delegate for the purpose aforesaid,

then the Town by their vote resolved this Meeting

Middlesex ss. To Mr. Samuel Knight Constable of
Ls. the Town of Sudbury in said County — Greeting
Ls. You are hereby required in the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, to Notify and warn the Inhabitants
Ls. of said Town of Sudbury duly qualified to vote for Representatives in the general court of said Commonwealth (By)
Ls. the male Inhabitants of said Town being twenty years of age, and resident in said Town, for the space of one year
proceedings, having a freehold estate within said Town of the annual income of three pound or any Estate to the value of sixty pounds, to assemble at the Meeting House in said Town on Monday the 6th day of Nov^r next, being the first Monday in said Month at one O'clock in the afternoon, to give in their votes for a Representative of the people of said Commonwealth, in the Congress of the United States, for the Middlesex District & Hereof you are not to fail of Making ^{an} return of this warrant with your doings thereon to some one of the selectmen previous to opening said Meeting
