wealth of Massachusetts to Notify and warn the Inhabitants
of said Town of Sudbury duly qualified to vote for Representation
in the general Court of said Commonwealth (viz) the male
Inhabitants of said Town being twenty one years of age, and
resident in said Town for the space of one year next pre-
ceding, having a Freehold Estate within said Town of
the annual income of three pounds or any Estate of the value
of sixty pounds, to assemble at the Meeting House in said Town
on Monday the 6th day of Nov^r next, being the first Monday
of said Month, at 2 o'clock in the afternoon, to give in their
votes for one elector for the Middlesex district, and two other
electors to be chosen by the people at large, for the purpose
of electing a President & Vice President of the United States
None of you are not to fail of making return of this warrant with
your doing thereon to some one of the selectmen previous to the
opening said Meeting, given under our hands & seals at Sudbury
