Es. the Town of Sudbury in said County a Greeting

Es. You are hereby required in the Name of the
Es. Commonwealth of Massachusetts to Notify and warn all
Es. the Freeholders and other Inhabitants of the Town of Sudbury
Es. Qualified by Law, to vote in Town affairs, to assemble at
Es. the Meeting House in said Town on Monday the 5th Day
of March next, at 10 O'clock in the forenoon, on said day
then and there, to act on the following Articles (Viz)

1st To choose a Moderator, Town Clerk, Selectmen Town Incom-
missioners, Constable and all other Town officers required
by Law, to be annually chosen in the Months of March or
April —

2^d To see if the Town will repair their Highway by a Rate
the present year, and grant a suitable sum of Money
for repairing the same —

3^d To see if the Town will give liberty for swine to go at
large the present year —

4th To see if the Town will give liberty for Horses, Mules and
Cattle to go at large the present year —

5th To see if the Town will give liberty for sheep to go at
large without a sheepard the present year —

6th To see if the Town will except of the Settlement of
the Selectmen with the Town Incom^{missioners} and order the same
to be recorded —

7th To see if the Town will take the same Measures for
the purpose of collecting the Taxes that may be assessed
upon the Inhabitants of said Town as was adopted the
year past and to agree with some suitable person
or persons to collect the same for the year ensuing to do or
act as the Town shall think best when met —

8th To see if the Town will appoint some suitable person
for a school Committee and authorize them to agree with
and hire school Instructors & Instructresses, to instruct all
the Public Schools in said Town for the year ensuing ^{to do or}

9th To see if the Town will attend to the report of the Trustees
of the Sudbury Ministerial fund Corporation the State of
the fund and the Interest arising thereon —
