

March Anno Domini 1821

By an act of the Legislature of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts passed June the 14. 1817 establishing a Ministerial ^{fund} in the Town of Sudbury Making it a duty of the Trustees thereof to make a report to the Town, the State of the funds and their doing thereon at the annual meeting in the Month of March or April agreeable to the said act, Ask leave to report as follows (Viz) That the Funded sum consists of the following Notes of hand bearing date August the 30th 1817 (Viz) —

Capt Silas Puffer Note of — 996 = 56

M^r. Lewis Moore Note of — 146 = 69

M^r. Israel Wheeler Note of — 154 = 40

M^r. Walter Haynes Note of — 200 = 31

M^r. Thaddeus Fowler Note of — 200 = 31

M^r. William Moore Note of — 406 = 87

Capt William Rice Note of — 376 = 86

M^r. Joshua Jones Note of — 382 = 15

M^r. Joel Moore Note of — 336 = 81

The total amount of the Funded sum amounts to 3200 = 94

The Interest arising from the Funded sum which was due August the 30th 1820 amounts to the sum of 181 92 = 05 which sum the Treas^r has since paid to the Rev^d Rufus Hurlbut agreeable to the act of Incorporation and by order of the said trustees thereof the sum of — \$ 192 = 05
