the Meeting House in said Town on Monday the
2^d Day of April next at One O'clock in the afternoon
on said Day then & there to give in their Votes for
the choice of Gov^t & Lient Gov^r of said Commonwealth
and Senators for the Middlesex District for the
year ensuing
