

-- April Anno Domini 1821 --

Middlesex & Sudbury April 2nd 1821 - Pursuant to the within warrant I have ^{duly} notified and warned the Inhabitants of said Town qualified as ^{the} Jurors expressed to meet at time and place and for the purposes therein mentioned --

Samuel Knight Constable

At a Legal Town Meeting held in Sudbury on Monday the 2^d day of April A.D. 1821 proceeded to the business of said day by bringing in their votes for a Moderator and they made choice 1st of Abel Wheeler Esq^r for their Moderator --

2^d Article brought in their votes for County Encumbrance as follows for John Keys Esq^r sixty two votes for Jed^d Thompson one vote --

3^d Article to fill up Vacancies in Town Officers and they made choice of Mr. Micah Balcom for their Town Encumbrance the year ensuing also made choice of Mr. Samuel Knight for their Constable the year ensuing and the above officers appeared before the Town Clerk the same evening & took the oath as the Law prescribed --

4th Article containing the 6th article in the warning of March Meeting and referred to April Meeting for further consideration and the Town voted to except of the settlement of the selectmen with the Town Encumbrance as was expressed in said article and ordered the same to be recorded and the same is recorded on the other next page --

Also the 12th article in the warning of March Meeting as contained in this 4th Article for the purpose of discounting taxes paid over to May Meeting 5th Article appropriated out of any unappropriated Money in the Town a sum sufficient to make up the deficiency in the poor grant in 1820 --

6th Article if was moved to see if the Town would act on this article & it passed in the affirmative then the Town voted that the Notice for choosing Jurors in future shall be by the Constable notifying the selectmen & Town Clerk, only without any other Notice

7th Article voted to choose a Committee as was expressed in this Article and the following gentlemen were chosen viz Capt ^{Samuel} ~~William~~ Brigham & Asher Goodnow

then it was moved to see to take up part of the 4th article again as it containing the 12th article in the warning of March Meeting & passed to April. & far as it respect ~~the~~ the discount of Mr. Walter Haynes taxes and it passed in the affirmative --

then the Town voted to discount to Mr. Walter Haynes the following taxes viz --
