you are hereby required in the name of the Common
wealth of Massachusetts to Notify and warn the male Inhabitants
of said Town being twenty one years of age, and resident in said
Town for the space of one year next preceding, having a freehold
estate within said Town of the annual income of three pounds
or any estate to the value of sixty pounds, to Meet at the Meeting
House in said Town on Monday the Ninth day of April next
at one O'clock in the afternoon, to give in their votes by
ballot for or against each of the said Articles of amendment
of the Constitution of this Commonwealth ———

Hereof you are not to fail of Making return of this
warrant with your doing thereon to some one of the
Selectmen previous to opening said Meeting —
Given under our hands & seal, that Sudbury aforesaid
this 29 Day of March A.D. 1821
