At a legal Meeting of the Freeholders and other Inhabitants of the Town of Sudbury, qualified to vote for Senators or Representative holders on the second Monday of April, A.D. 1821, pursuant to a Resolution of the Convention of Delegates assembled at Boston the 15th November, A.D. 1820 for the purpose of revising the Constitution of the Commonwealth
